



YOUNG PERSON PERMISSION SLIP

As you may be aware, wheeled sports are high-risk activities. We need to make it clear to parents and young people that One Eighty is NOT LIABLE for any damage or injury caused by skating.

A sign is displayed at all times recommending that full safety equipment is used on the park, of which we are able to provide helmets only. If you require your child to wear the equipment, it is your responsibility to make sure they do so. We cannot force young people to wear protective gear, we can only recommend and provide it for them.

A qualified first aider is present at every session and full ground and ramp checks are made before anyone can use the ramps. Full copies of our policies and procedures can be provided on request.

We make take photos and produce videos occasionally to promote the work of One Eighty and Bath Youth for Christ, these will only be used for this purpose.
